Position: Tenure track position at the Assistant Professor level (60% research, 40% instruction) in the area of dairy foods; specific research areas include, but are not limited to, the examination of structure/function relationships, novel processing technologies, and biological and nutritional aspects of milk components.

Responsibilities: the successful candidate will show evidence and/or potential to: develop a strong, independent, competitively-funded research program; teach an undergraduate course in dairy foods (chemistry and technology of dairy products); develop a graduate level course in their field of expertise (that also emphasizes the multi-disciplinary nature of food science and complements the existing graduate courses offered within the Department); develop collaborative relationships within Food Science, the Wisconsin Center for Dairy Research and the University; and contribute to outreach, extension and service functions of the Department, College, and University.

Requirements: Earned doctorate in Food Science, Chemistry/Biochemistry, or related area is required. Post-doctoral experience is highly desirable. To apply, submit: cover letter; CV; one-page statements of interest or philosophy in teaching and research; all college transcripts; and arrange for three letters of recommendation to be sent to:
